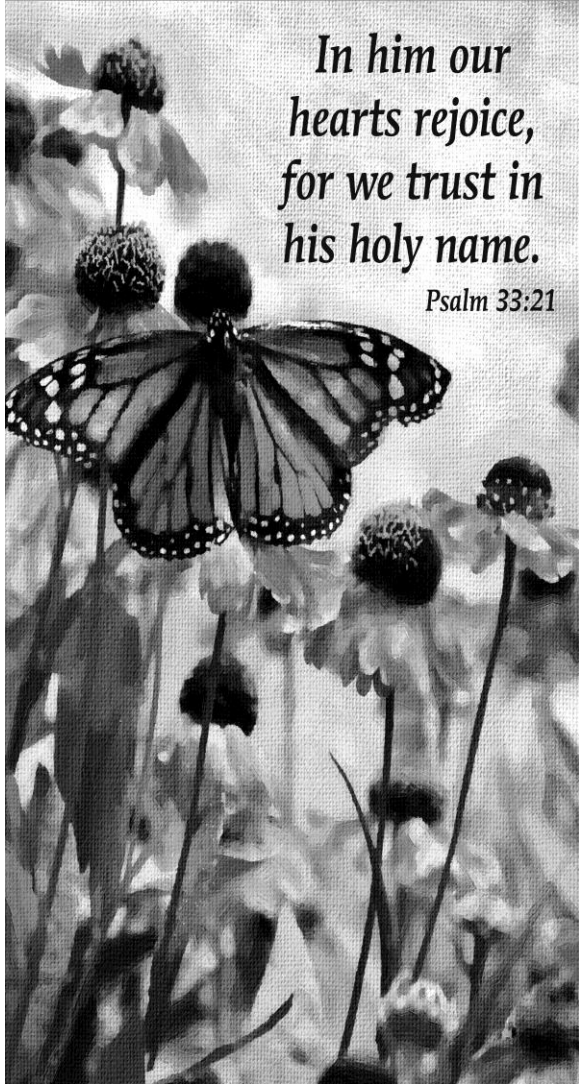

Financials

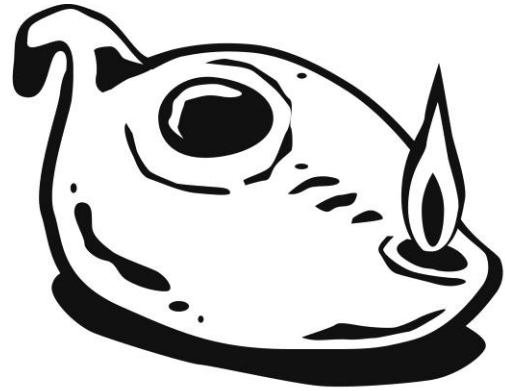
Income for June was \$16,103.37 and expenses were \$14,302.92 for a net of \$1,800.45.
