Pastor's Corner

Bearing One Another's Burden

Galatians 6:1 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. Jesus taught this concept and even more important he modeled it in His earthly ministry. In Isaiah 53 the prophet pictures the, "suffering servant", which Jesus fulfilled. Jesus washed the disciples' feet. Jesus told the disciples, and us, to serve each other.

Mark 2:1-12 gives the account of four friends who literally carried a friend to Jesus so that the man could be healed. The scripture says that Jesus saw the faith of the four friends and He responded by forgiving and healing the man they brought. This is a picture of what we need to do for people today. All of us know people who need to be brought to Jesus. One way that we can do this is to pray for people. Some people do not even realize that they need Jesus. They are self-sufficient and they may think that they are doing alright. But everyone needs Jesus. We all need His salvation and we need His guidance.

Even as strong and as close to God as the Apostle Paul was, he asked often for people to pray for him. Paul himself wrote letters to the churches in different places and told the people he was praying for them. It was Paul who wrote the

words quoted above, "bear one another's burdens".

Various scriptures call upon us to encourage each other. Discouragement is a problem to all of us. Christians can get discourage. In fact discouragement seems to be one of satan's primary tools to undermine our faith and to keep us from doing the work of God.

In first Corinthians 12 Paul uses the body as an illustration of our interrelatedness. Each part has its own function and each part is needed by the rest of the body. If one part does not function the whole body suffers. "If one part suffers, every part suffers with it, if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it." Not one of us is so strong that we do not need help and support at times. We are to help others and they in turn are to help us.

Fellowship is a very important part of the Christian life. It is good for us to spend time with other Christians. It helps us stay on a right path and it is enjoyable to interact with those who are part of our spiritual family.

This is Thanksgiving time and I am thankful for you as a church family. We are blessed to fellowship with you. You are an encouragement and help to Debbie and me. God Bless You! Pastor Bob


