God has been blessing our congregation. We are so glad to have several new people as part of our fellowship. A number of the youth and young adult groups are starting to attend more regularly and a couple of new families have also joined us. We welcome you and hope that you are finding what you need for your spiritual life. I am so thankful that our people are loving and that they make newcomers feel welcome.

God has blessed the youth group which is growing. The youth are going next week to the state youth convention. Pray for them. Cody Rader has really been a great help to Jeremy with the group.

The remodel work in the basement is coming along nicely. For those who do not know that area is where the youth meet on Wednesday evening. The young adult "Life Group" meets there on Tuesday evening and the young adult group has a worship service downstairs on Sunday evening at 8:00.

We started the Bible 101 study last Sunday evening. Quite a number of people had made the comment that they did not know much about the Bible. Even some who have been in church for years felt a need to dig deeper into the scripture. So this class is an attempt to meet those needs. It is my intention to help you learn where to find things in the Bible. We will also be studying great stories in the Bible. Part of the structure will also explore important basic teaching of the Bible. I hope that everyone will be encouraged to study and read the Bible even more often. In order to keep the study moving and

alive, I will be alternating content and structure week by week. I hope you will ask questions so I will know what to share more effectively.

Starting on Monday, February 24 thousands of people around the country will be involved in a program designed to read the entire New Testament by Easter. The Bibles are \$7 each. In addition to reading there will be discussion groups meeting each week in different churches and locations around town. These groups will be about one hour long and just an open discussion forum.

Let me encourage you to make an effort to grow in your spiritual life through this late winter and early spring time. Spend time in prayer. Read the Bible. Be faithful in church attendance. Invite a friend to come to church with you. The more you invest and work at your spiritual life the more you will progress. Your growth largely depends on you.
